

CFF Canada Cup Fee Structure

The Canadian Fencing Federation (“CFF”) has decided to outsource the running of its Canada Cup tournaments (“Tournament”). This Tournament was formerly known as the Canada Section Circuit (“CSC”) and includes registrations in all official and unofficial events held under its name including, but not limited to Cadet, Junior, Senior, Team, U15, U13, recreational, and veteran events. Organizations will be able to apply to host these Tournaments subject to meeting certain technical requirements, tournament format requirements, and the payment of a fee.

Please note that by signing a contract to host a Canada Cup Tournament, you are agreeing to pay the following fee structure. At no time will the Canadian Fencing Federation bear the burden of any losses incurred by the hosting organization (“Host”) nor will it have any claim on any monies earned, other than those set out in this guideline, by the Host.

The Host, upon successfully bidding and signing a contract with the CFF, agrees to pay the following fees associated with the Tournament:

Base Fee

The Host agrees to pay the CFF the sum of \$2500 (“Base Fee”). This money must be submitted with the signed contract to host the Tournament. Failure to submit the Base Fee with the signed contract may result in the Tournament being rebid and/or reassigned to another organization.

Registrant Fee

The Host agrees to pay the CFF a sliding-scale fee (“Registrant Fee”) based on the number of total registrants entered in the Tournament. The Registrant fee is calculated based on the following:

- 500 or less registrants: 0% of total registration fees captured
- 501 to 550 registrants: 2% of total registration fees captured
- 551 to 600 registrants: 6% of total registration fees captured
- 601 to 650 registrants: 15% of total registration fees captured
- Greater than 651 registrants: 25% of total registration fees captured

The Registrant Fee must be submitted to the Canadian Fencing Federation along with the results of the competition no later than 14 days after the close of the last Tournament. Failure to submit the results and Registrant Fee after 14 days will result in a 1.5% per month service charge on the outstanding fees.

The CFF reserves the right to audit the Tournament’s registration numbers, documents (written and electronic), and communications’.
