

CFF Domestic Competitions Payment policy

Rationale:

The CFF incurs ongoing costs both for staff time and system costs for the maintenance of the Domestic Ranking system. The fees are charged for this service to offset the costs incurred.

Where competition results files have been received in an incorrect format or with data errors, considerable CFF staff time has been invested in working with the Branch offices or competition organizers in resolving these problems. CFF time and resources invested in this problem solving takes away from time scheduled for other tasks. Competition organizers have a responsibility to the athletes who they are charging competition fees, to ensure that the competition is run according to a set of norms and the data and results are accurate. The resubmission fees are implemented to offset some of the CFF costs and to encourage competition organizers to ensure that they have met their requirements.

Tournament Registration:

The 'registration fee' (CFF Fee Schedule) is required from the provincial branch / competition organizers no less than 30 days prior to the start of the event. Additional fees may be charged if less than 30 days prior. The registration fee is required prior to the event.

Event Ranking:

A 'ranking fee' is payable for each event submitted from a tournament to the CFF for ranking.

The provincial branch / competition organizers will submit the payment online for the number of events less one when the results are uploaded to the CFF.

The tournament 'registration fee' acts as the 'ranking fee' for the first event.
