REGISTER:

Registration deadline is March 29th, 2019. Late registrations will be accepted up to April 3rd but will be assessed a \$40 per event late fee. Refunds of <u>event fees only</u> will be provided for withdrawals before the March 29th deadline, or for schedule changes made by the tournament organizers.

RULES:

-Events will be considered as combined male/female events unless a minimum of 6 fencers per gender is reached, then events will run as male/female events for that category.

-Events with less than six fencers will be canceled.

-Fencers may enter more than one event, but if a conflict of timing arises, they may be required to withdraw from an event.

-All events require fencers to have a valid CFF license, and competitive provincial membership, or membership with another federation.

-The latest FIE rules will apply except regarding Kevlar clothing and maraging blades. All participants must have a mask (electric bib for foil), jacket, sous plastron, breeches, socks, two weapons and two wires.
