Who is this pathway for? This pathway is for coaches who work with competitive fencers in the Train To Compete LTD stage and want to provide them with meaningful feedback to address performance gaps that limit competitive success. The workshop will address a wide range of factors that influence performance in competition including psychological and social/emotional factors in addition to technical-tactical skills and physical capacities. Beyond club training, development coaches often work at provincial or national training camps in addition to provincial, national and international competitions. Certification in this pathway is required to coach at Canada Games.

Additional requirements for NCCP certification

- Be 18 years or older
- Possess a valid CFF membership licence
- Provide a valid Basic First Aid certificate
- Provide a criminal record check
- Provide proof of sport safety training completion as required by your province or territory

Certified coaches are encouraged to regularly upgrade their knowledge and skills. To maintain certification, Competition Development coaches must earn 30 professional development (PD) points within 5 years of certification.
