




Competition Introduction Coach



Who is this pathway for? This pathway is for coaches who want to focus on introducing and developing fencers for competitions, while respecting LTD. Key learning outcomes include: building your competitive coaching profile, planning practices for and supporting competitive fencers in training, designing and managing a competitive fencing program, providing support to fencers in competition (provincial and national), and analyzing fencing performance. Much of the practical portion of the workshop develops individual lesson skills, performance analysis and ways to provide effective feedback in competitions.

- Possess a valid CFF/PTSO coach membership license
